



NOTICE TO RESIDENTS

Barberry Street Relief Sewer Project

June 18, 2026

The City of Southgate awarded a construction contract to Dan's Excavating, Inc. (Contractor) of Shelby Township, Michigan, on March 4, 2026, to construct a relief sewer in Barberry Street from Eureka Road to Brest Street. As part of this sewer project, the Contractor is continuing sewer work from Eureka Road to Mercier Street. **The Contractor will continue northward with the Barberry Street pavement removal operation on Saturday, June 20, 2026, to just south of the Barberry Street and Phelps Street intersection.** The Contractor will also continue with the installation of the relief sewer in Barberry Street and water main work on Veronica Street and Phelps Street next week.

Traffic Control and Detours

Barberry Street is closed to traffic from Eureka Road north to Phelps Street. Traffic will not be able to access Barberry Street between Howard Street and Fort Street, from Mercier Street and Veronica Street. We anticipate this street closure to last approximately 2 months. Phelps Street will remain open to east and west traffic until further notice.

Parking

Due to the Contractor's truck traffic on Veronica Street and Phelps Street, we kindly ask that you do not park on these streets between Barberry Street and Fort Street. Parking restrictions on adjacent side streets will not be enforced during construction, except for parking in front of fire hydrants or too close to intersections. These infractions will still be enforced. There will be no parking allowed on Barberry Street during construction. We kindly ask that you remove your vehicle and any trailer from your garage before the Contractor approaches your address to perform sewer work. The Southgate Department of Public Safety is aware of this construction, and precautions will be taken for safety protection of this street.

Working Hours

Working hours will typically be from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, with occasional work taking place on Saturdays. The Contractor will not work on holidays or holiday weekends.

Future resident notices will be provided during construction to keep you informed. When construction begins, if you have any questions or concerns, the best source of information is to locate the full-time, on-site construction inspector from Hennessey Engineers.
